How the demonstrations will work...

- Ist Demo, by Shinji Suzuki starts on 8 Oct at 10am Perth West Australia time.
- Registrants login just prior to see the full demo. If login is say 10 minutes later, you will miss the first 10 minutes of his demo.
- 8 hours later you are free to access that same demo as a recording and view it as many times as you like until 30 Oct, with normal start/stop/rewind/freeze etc. functions.
- All other demo's operate the same way, i.e. login on time as advised in the Program to see the full demo on its first run and access it again at any time up until 30 Oct to view it as a recording.
- At the immediate completion of demo's by Shinji and Michael there will be live Q & A sessions that you can participate in.
- There will be a time clock showing times in different zones.

How the Exhibitions will work

- You will have a choice of Exhibitions to view, the main ones being the Bonsai and Suiseki in Australian and New Zealand Collections.
- We will have as many collection quality Australian and New Zealand Natives as Bonsai as we possibly can. This Exhibition will also include exotic species.
