

39th EBA Convention

Organised by the Lithuanian Bonsai Association 3 - 5 October 2025 Palanga, Klaipeda, Lithuania



The already very difficult social, political, economic, and military situation in Europe and the world has worsened further in recent months. This is affecting many areas of society, including clubs and associations with their planned activities and events.

We are therefore pleased that the Lithuanian Bonsai Association is holding its "Japan Art and Culture Festival" together with the "EBA-ESA Convention" this autumn.

In cooperation with the organisers and the EBA Board, we can now provide members with the most up-to-date information about the organisation and the venue.

The organisers have provided extensive documentation, which is attached.

The attached program shows that the organising team, led by Kestutis Ptakauskas, has put together many very interesting and unique lectures, workshops, shows, and demonstrations related to Japanese culture and art for visitors, in addition to the EBA Meetings (Board, Round Table, Annual General Meeting) and the EBA New Talent Contest (NTC).

The event is spread across various locations in Palanga. These are detailed in the program for each individual item.

The Bonsai and Suiseki Exhibition will take place in the halls of the Palanga Cultural Centre, (Palangos Kurhausas, Grafų Tiškevičių al. 1, Palanga, 00135, Lithuania), where the bonsai delivery point is also located.

The EBA New Talent Contest (NTC) with participants from EBA member countries will be held there (Palanga Kurhausas Theatre Hall).

Another venue is the Palanga Concert Hall (Vytauto g. 43, Palanga) for the Japan Art and Culture Festival, the opening ceremony, and the EBA meetings.

The Palanga Resort Museum (Birutės al. 34A, Palanga) will be available for lectures and workshops.

The organisers will announce further details for the gala dinner in due course.

The trading area will be provided free of charge right next to the exhibition venue (outdoors).

Registration of Bonsai:

For the correct registration of the EBA trees each national association must select their bonsai they will present at the exhibition. The number of trees per country is limited to 3 – 5. It is most important that the organisers are able to manage the space for the exhibits.

The organisers kindly ask all exhibitors of bonsai and Suiseki to arrive in Palanga by Friday, 3 October 2025. The exhibition must be fully set up and ready by 12:00 pm on 3 October.

Please send a list of the bonsai you plan to exhibit no later than 21 July to Kęstutis Ptakauskas – <u>info@bonsai.lt</u> **and** to the EBA-Secretary <u>detlef.mostler@aon.at</u> . The list needs to include:

- The full name of the tree owner, their email address and mobile number
- The name of the species of the bonsai

Each owner has to register the exhibition bonsai using the "EBA 2025 Palanga, Participant registration – Bonsai" on the official website of the EBA-ESA Convention no later than 21 July.

If we do not receive this information by the deadline, the organisers will fill the space with other exhibitors.

If there are questions concerning the registration process please contact Kęstutis Ptakauskas <u>info@bonsai.lt</u>. The deadline for submitting the lists is the 21July 2025 but we ask you to write to us a short notice of a planned participation or non-participation in the exhibition instantly.

Because some EBA Members are not able to participate in the exhibition the board will ask other Members of EBA, especially from the nearby countries, to provide and bring more trees if requested by the organisers.

It is also important to tell us if you will exhibit less than 3 bonsai. If this is the case the organisers can then pass the free places to other exhibitors.



1. Registration

All events are free of charge, with the exception of:

- •Theatre Performance: "The Buddha in the Attic" (Friday after the opening ceremony)
- Jazz Concert: (Sunday) Please see the attached program.

2. NTC (EBA - New Talents Contest©)

Participants in the EBA - NTC have to be nominated by the Member Countries (EBA Delegates). The deadline will be 1 September 2025.

Send the name and email-address of your participant and of your country's NTC-Judge to detlef.mostler@aon.at and to Gytis Volungevičius gytis@serveris.lt as soon as possible. If you don't know the names until 1 September 2025 please send us a notice that your country will participate in any case in the NTC and you will give us the names in time. All participants will receive free of charge a ticket for the Gala Dinner. The NTC will take place on Saturday, 4 October 10:00 to 14:00 at the venue Palanga Kurhausas Theatre-Hall. All participants and judges will receive additional information about the NTC procedures by the EBA Secretary.

In case your member country does not participate in the NTC please send a short notice about this fact to detlef.mostler@aon.at and gytis@serveris.lt as soon as possible.

As in the past accommodation must be organised (booked and paid) by the national association or by the participant themselves!
